- A group of words that makes a complete sense is called a sentence.

EX:- Ram is a good boy. Sentence

• a boy Ram is Not a sentence.

• Types of Sentences :->

① Statement / Declarative :->

The sentences which states or says something is called statement sentences

EX:- She likes football.

My father reads newspapers.

② Question or Interrogative Sentence :->

The sentence which asks question about something or somebody is called question sentence. It ends with question mark.

EX:- Is this your pen?

Do you have your pencil with you?

③ Imperative sentence ⇒

The sentence which gives command, request, order, advise and suggest for something to be done is called an Imperative sentence.

Ex:- Don't eat so much junk food.
You should walk on the left side of the road.
Open the door.

④ Exclamatory sentences ⇒

The sentence which expresses a strong or sudden feeling is called an exclamatory sentences.

Ex- What a beautiful flower it is!
Bravo, we won the match!
Ouch! I hurt my leg.
