

ROUNDING OFF NUMBERS TO THE NEAREST TEN:

Rounding means making a number simpler but keeping its value close to what it was.

The result is less accurate, but easier to use.

* FOR EXAMPLE: Round 56 to the nearest 10 →

Ans → 56 is rounded up to 60.

Because if the ones digit of a number is 5 or more than 5, then that number is rounded up to the nearest ten.

* EXAMPLE: Round 83 to the nearest 10 →

Ans → 83 is rounded down to 80

Because, if the ones digit of a number is 4 or less than 4, then that number is rounded down to the nearest ten.

EVEN AND ODD NUMBERS:

EVEN NUMBERS:

* Numbers that can be put in pairs are called even numbers.

* A number which is divisible by 2 and generates a remainder of 0 is called an even number.

* Even numbers always ends (with digits 0, 2, 4, 6 and 8).

ODD NUMBERS:

* Numbers that can not be paired are called odd numbers.

* A number which is not divisible by 2 is called an odd number.

* Odd numbers always ends (with digits ~~odd~~ 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9).

FOR EXAMPLE: 1) 123(4) → An even number

2) 104(5) → An odd number.

ROUNDING OFF NUMBERS

Divas, the stationer, had noted the number of pencils and erasers in his shop. But he has lost the note. He remembers that there were about 50 pencils and 80 erasers.



The numbers 50 and 80 are close to the exact numbers.

These numbers are said to be **rounded off**.

Later, Divas found the note.

There were exactly

47 pencils and 82 erasers in his shop.

47 is close to 50.
So I rounded it
UP to 50.

82 is close to 80.
So I rounded it
DOWN to 80.

A number is rounded DOWN to the nearest ten if the ones digit is 4 or less.



A number is rounded UP to the nearest ten if the ones digit is 5 or more.



EVEN AND ODD NUMBERS

Even numbers can be put in pairs (groups of 2). 6 is even.



Nothing is left over.

Odd numbers have one left over when you put them in pairs.

7 is odd.



1 is left over.

Even numbers end with 2, 4, 6, 8, or 0.
