

ORDERING NUMBERS →

When we write numbers from the smallest to greatest, they are in increasing order or ascending order.

When we write numbers from the greatest to smallest, they are in decreasing order or descending order.

FOR EXAMPLE :-

⇒ 103, 97, 145

In increasing order → 97, 103, 145

In decreasing order → 145, 103, 97

ORDER OF NUMBERS

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WITH DIVISION AND FRACTIONS
