

A group of words that contains a verb and makes complete sense is called a **sentence**.
A sentence begins with a capital letter and ends with a full stop, a question mark or an exclamation mark.

Sentences are of four kinds.

1. A **statement** states or says something.

EXAMPLE: Robert likes strawberries.

2. A **question** asks things. It ends with a question mark.

EXAMPLE: Does Robert like strawberries?

3. A **command** or a **request** gives directions for something to be done. A command ends with a full stop.

EXAMPLE: Robert, don't eat so many strawberries.

4. An **exclamatory sentence** expresses a strong or sudden feeling.

An exclamatory sentence ends with an exclamation mark.

EXAMPLE: Oh, how delicious these strawberries are!
