A sentence beginning a verb and makes complete sense is called a sentence. A sentence begins with a capital letter and ends with a full stop, a question mark or an exclamation mark.

Sentences are of four kinds. 1. A statement states or says something.

Example: Robert likes strawberries. 2. A question asks things. It ends with a question mark.

Example: Does Robert like strawberries?

3. A command or a request gives directions for something to be done. A command ends with a full stop.

EXAMPLE: Robert, don't eat so many strawberries.

4. An exclamatory sentence expresses a strong or sudden feeling. An exclamatory sentence ends with an exclamation mark.

Example: Oh, how delicious these strawberries arel
