① How do babies stay alive inside their mother's womb?

Ans: Babies stay alive inside their mother's womb through a tube from the mother's body which carries food and oxygen to the baby's body.

② What will happen if animals do not produce more of their own kind?

Ans: If animals do not produce more of their own kind, their <sup>own</sup> kind will die out completely.

③ What is reproduction?

Ans: The process by which all living things produce more of their kind is called reproduction.



④ what is adoption?

Ans: when someone brings up another person's child as their own is called adoption.

⑤ who are foster parents?

Ans: The parents who look after the adopted child are the foster parents of the child.

Imp Notes:

Adopted child: when someone brings up a child who is not born to them that child who is cared for is called adopted child.
