

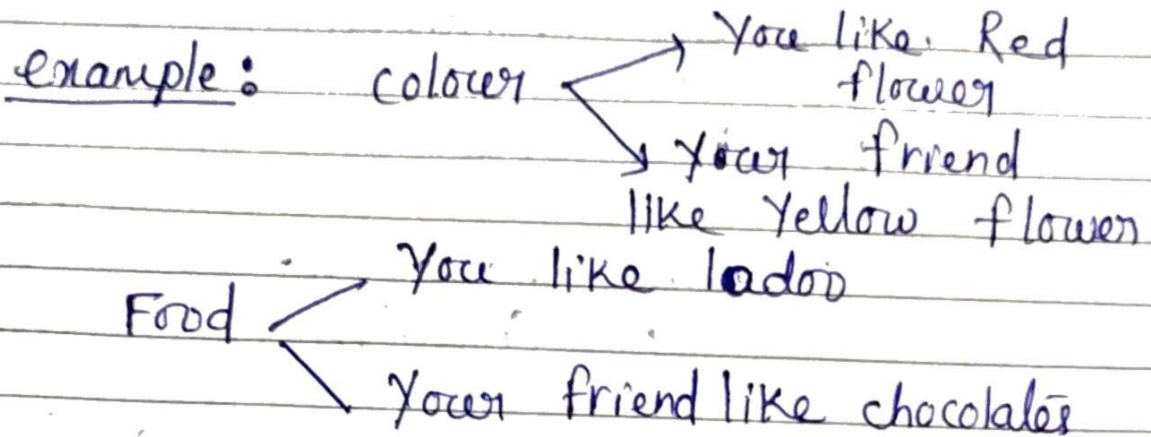

People with special Needs:

Differently-abled : People who are

unable to use ^{one or} more of their senses are called differently-abled.

Note : when one of the senses do not work [or damaged], other senses become sharper to make up for it.

e.g. : Those who can't see, can recognize people by hearing voice or by their touch etc.
