

POSSESSIVES

An apostrophe () is used to show possession.

The possessive of a plural noun is formed in two ways.

1. by adding an apostrophe if the word ends in s

EXAMPLE: horses' manes

2. by adding an apostrophe and s if the word does not end in s

Example: children's toys
