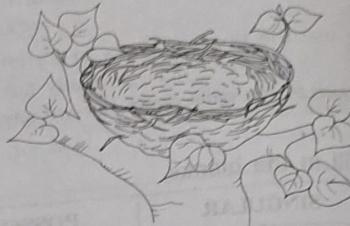

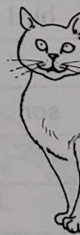

POSSESSIVES

An apostrophe (') is used to show possession.
The possessive of a plural noun is formed in two ways.

1. by adding an apostrophe if the word ends in **s**
EXAMPLE: horses' manes
2. by adding an apostrophe and **s** if the word does not end in **s**
EXAMPLE: children's toys

We use the possessive ('s or s') form of nouns in relation to people and most animals.
It is generally not used for nouns that name things.

EXAMPLE: the girl's dress but we say: the colour of the book (and not the book's colour)
