## Animal Products We Use

- ① Cod fish → cod liver oil  
[Rich source of vitamins]
- ② Silkworm → Silk
- ③ Animal Skin → Leather products  
[Belt, Bags, Shoes]
- ④ Sheep & goat → Woolen cloth
- ⑤ Fish waste, Bird dropping → Fertilizers

## Animals In Danger :

\* Some animals are hunted for their

- Skin [ To make leather items ]
- Fur [ To make jackets and coats ]
- Bones
- Tusk (of elephant) ⇒ Sold at very high price

Q: what is poaching?

Ans: → It means an illegal hunting or capturing of wild animals

→ It is a crime against wildlife

Poachers:

The people who kill the animals are known as poachers.

Q: what do you mean by extinct?

Ans: The term extinct refers to an animal or plant species [types of plant] when there are no more individuals of that species alive anywhere in the world.

Example: Dinosaur are extinct

[Disappeared / dying out from earth]

Endangered Animals:

It is any type of animal that is in danger of disappearing forever.

Example:

- Elephant, Tiger, Lion, Rhinoceros
  - Tibetan antelope (chiru)
  - Olive Ridley turtle
  - Black Buck
  - Musk deer, great Indian bustard
- \* That's why hunting is now banned.

\* National parks and wildlife sanctuaries have set up by government to protect animals and to save forests.

National parks → 100  
wildlife sanctuaries → 500
