Most animals live and move around in groups

Why animals stay together in group?

- To find food and water
- To protect themselves from enemies
- To raise their young ones.

Animal Groups:

Herd: Each group of animal is called a herd.

* Animals that live in group are:

- cows
- Buffaloes
- Horses
- Elephants
- Wildebeest
- Zebras
- deer.

Elephant Herd :

* 10 or more female elephants with their calves lives together

* Oldest female elephant → leads the group

↓
→ She takes the decision

→ She protects the herd members from enemies

→ others follow her

* Male elephant → lives for some years and then moves away.

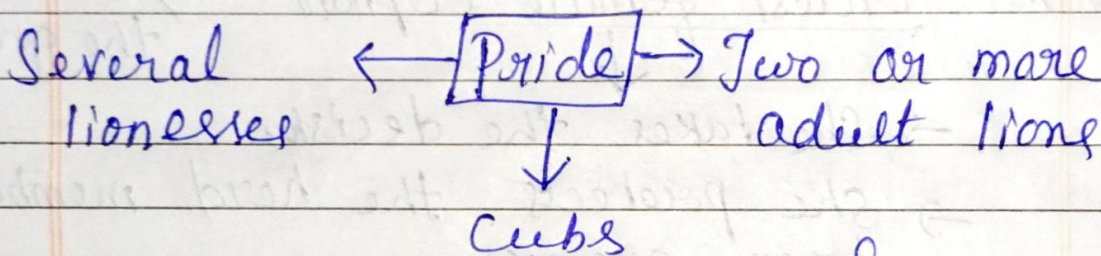
Wildebeest :

* They move in a herd in search of water and grassland.

* They blindly follow their leader across rivers and forest.

Lion Herd :

* Pride : A group of lions is called a pride.



* Lionesses $\xrightarrow{\text{do}}$ Hunting

* Injured lioness \rightarrow Lives on meat brought by the other lionesses of the pride

Band : A group of chimpanzees, gorillas or monkey is called a band.

* Chimpanzees \rightarrow Live in a group of 15 to 80.

* The mother chimpanzees and her

babies form a smaller group within the large group

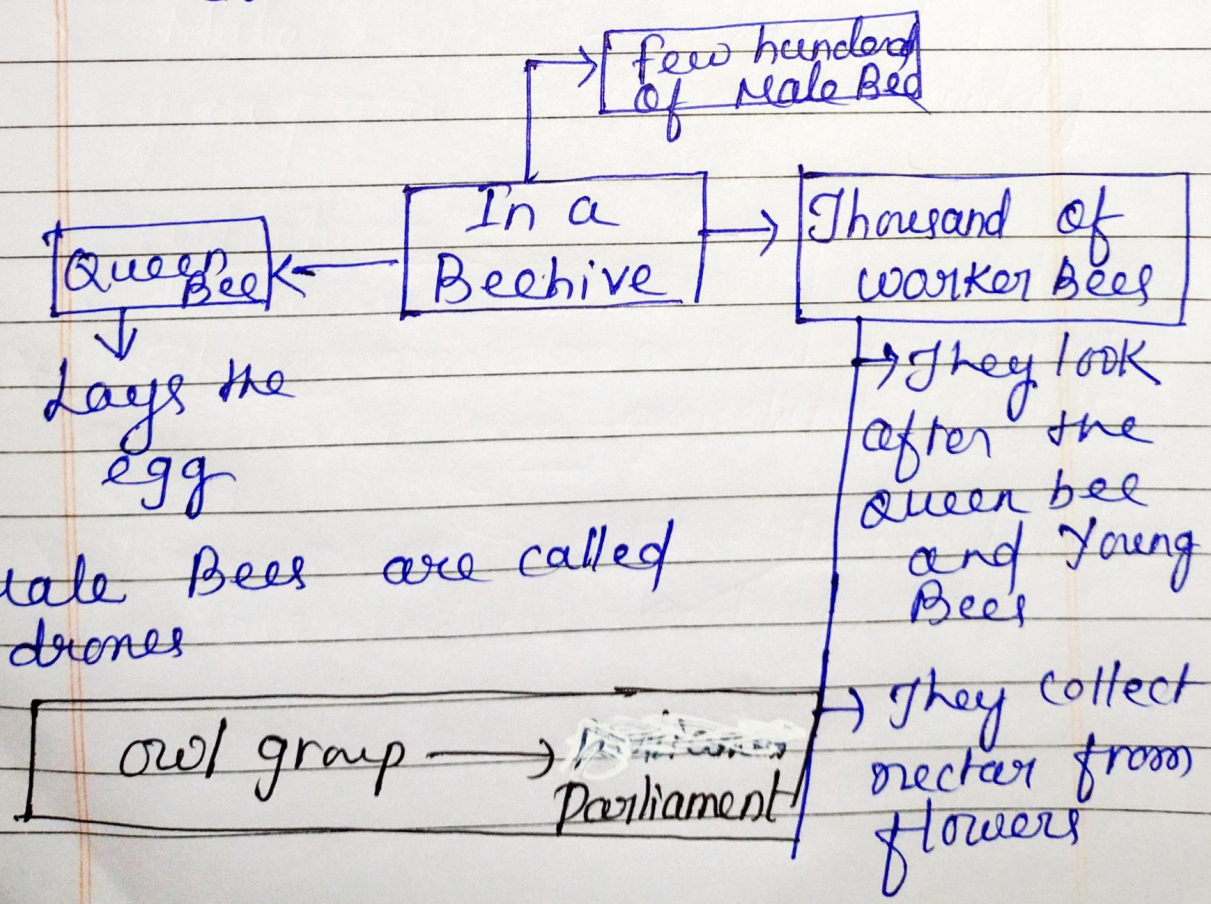
* They communicate with each other by facial expressions and gestures.

Bees:

* A group of bees is called Swarm.
