2. The smallest multiple of 7 is 7

3. The first multiple of 12 is 12

4. The first three multiples of 8 are 8, 16 and 24

5. $6 \times 9 = 54$. 54 is a multiple of 6 and 9



Fill in the blanks.

- $7 \times 8 = 56$. Therefore 56 is the multiple of 7 and 8.
- 15 is the smallest multiple of 15.
- $4 \times 7 = 28$. 28 is a multiple of 4 and 7.
- $6 \times 5 = 30$. The multiple of 6 and 5 is 30.
- 5, 10, 15 and 20 are multiples of 5.
