Consonants - B, C, D, F, G, H, J, K
L, M, N, P, Q, R, S, T, V,
W, X, Y, Z.

Articles

Indefinite
(A/An)

Definite
(The)

* A and an are articles. These are indefinite articles.

* We use 'a' before words that begin with a consonant or consonant sound.

Examples

I had a heavy breakfast.

a glass

a girl

a lion

a university

a car

We use the before some proper nouns. It is used before the names of

- * mountain ranges - the Alps, the Himalaya, the Nilgiris
- * Oceans and Seas - the Arctic Ocean, the Indian Ocean, the Arabian Sea.
- * rivers - the Indus, the Amazon
- * famous monuments - the Taj Mahal, the Vivekananda Memorial
- * certain books and newspapers - the Bible, the Hindu
- * things that are only one of their kind - the Earth, the Sun
