There are three articles – a, an, the. We use a before words that begin with a consonant sound. We use an instead of a before words that begin with a vowel sound. EXAMPLES: There is a tiger in the jungle. Take an umbrella with you because it is raining outside. Some words may begin with a vowel but may have a consonant sound. In such cases we use a before the word. EXAMPLES: Gopal has gone to study at a university in England. Anne Marie is a European. In these cases, the pronunciation of u is yu and y is a consonant. Some words may begin with a consonant but may have a vowel sound. EXAMPLES: Raman has gone out for an hour. (h is silent, so the word begins with the vowel sound of o) Mridula is an MA in history. (the pronunciation of M is em, so the letter M begins with the vowel sound of e)

There was a jamun tree in the forest. The tree was twenty years old.

The is called the definite article.

The definite article is also used when we talk about a particular thing. EXAMPLE: We went to Agra to see the Taj Mahal.

The is also used when we wish to use a noun to represent a whole class. EXAMPLES: The peacock is said to be a proud bird. The computer stores and analyses information.

We use the before some proper nouns. It is used before the names of
