Forest :

- * This is a large area of land thickly covered with trees, bushes and creepers.
- * These are found in areas where there is sufficient rainfall.
- * One-fifth of the India's total area is covered by forest.
[It should be one-third]

Forest Found :

- Rainy slopes of Western Ghats
- Hills of eastern India.
- Islands [Andaman and Nicobar]
- Himalayan Mountain
- Southern Plateaus
- West Bengal, Odisha.

Types of Forests:

- ① → Tropical Rainforests
- ② → Tropical Deciduous forests
- ③ → Desert vegetation
- ④ → Mountain vegetation
- ⑤ → Mangrove forests
↳ example: Sunderbans

Note: Types of forest depend on

→ Rainfall

→ Kind of soil

→ Climate

Importance of Forests:

* Trees supply oxygen to breathe.

* Trees help to form rainfall.

- * They prevent soil erosion.
- * They keep the atmosphere cool.
- * Every part of a tree is useful
- * coconut leaves used → Thatch the roof
- * Leaves of neem tree → Medicinal purpose
- * Barks of tree → cinnamon [flavoring fwd]
- * Some parts used for → dyes
 - cosmetics
 - Medicine
- * Forest are important natural resource.
- * Forest play a major role in improving the quality of environment.

Ecosystem:

All living things which depend on each other for survival, together form an ecosystem.

Deforestation:

The cutting down of trees on a large scale is called deforestation.

Why we cut down forests?

* To get timber.

* To provide land for cultivation.

* To build factories and roads.

Effects of Deforestation:

* It results soil erosion.

* Because of soil erosion, soil

loses the fertility so decrease in agricultural products.

* It leads to food shortage and famines

famines: extreme scarcity of food.

* We can't get pure air to breathe.

There are two ways to protect our forests:

→ Afforestation

→ Reforestation.

Afforestation: The planting of tree in an area that was not a forest is called afforestation.

Programmes like → Social Forestry Movement
motivates people
to plant trees. → Vanmahotsava

Reforestation:

The planting of trees on deforested land is called reforestation.

Protected areas:

- Reserved Forests
- National Parks
- Wildlife Sanctuaries

Sacred groves:

- * Sacred groves means "forest of Gods and Goddesses".
- * Here People believe that the grove is sacred and worship certain trees in the forest.

Largest No of Sacred groves → Himachal Pradesh.
