

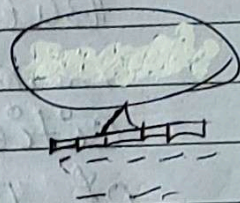

ARTICLES

① Articles are words that are used to clarify a noun.

There are two types of 'Articles'.

- ① Indefinite articles
- ② Definite articles



1. INDEFINITE ARTICLES.

- 'a' and 'an' are indefinite articles.
- We can't use indefinite articles before uncountable nouns.
- We use 'a' before consonant sound words. And 'an' before vowel sound words.
- When we refer to habitual action we use indefinite articles.

2. DEFINITE ARTICLES.

- 'The' is a definite article.
- Before uncountable noun we use 'the'.
- Before the superlative form we use 'the'.
- Before the ordinal numbers like

(2nd, 3rd, 5th), names of musical instruments, some nouns like rivers, oceans, deserts, buildings, monuments, newspapers, holy books, trains we use 'the'.

But we can't use any articles before names of people, continents, countries, cities, the names of languages, names of relatives (father, mother, uncle)
