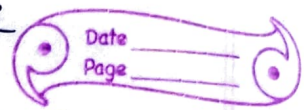

Q. What are possessive pronouns?

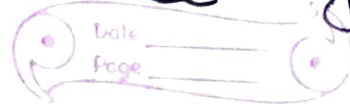
Ans- Possessive pronouns are used to replace a noun and to show possession or ownership.
