

ADJECTIVES.

- Definition :- The words which describe the nouns or pronouns in the sentences are called Adjectives.

Adjectives are also called describing words.

EX:- Vijay is a good boy.

- Types of Adjectives :->

- ① Adjective of quality:- words that describe quality of noun or pronoun.

EX:- I have a nice teddy.
It is a cute teddy.

- ② Adjective of quantity:- words that describe quantity of noun or pronoun.

EX:- few, some, many, little, all, enough.

I have many apples with me.

Some planets have few moon.

- ③ Adjective of number / Numerical adjectives:- words that shows how many persons or things are there.

EX:- There are four books in the shelf.

The Earth is the fifth planet.
