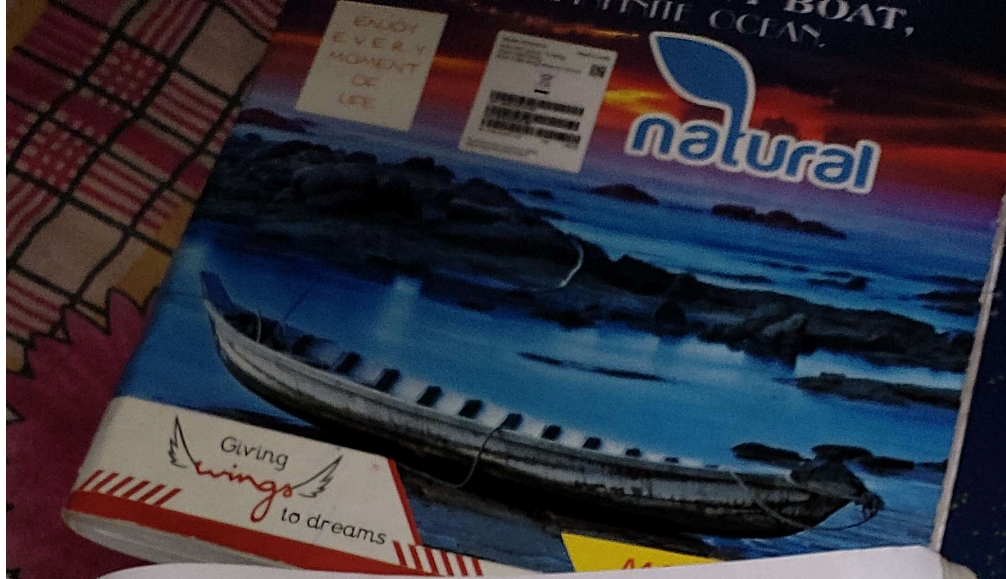
A **relative pronoun** refers to or relates to a noun used earlier in the sentence.



A pronoun used to express possession or ownership is known as a **possessive pronoun**.
Mine, his, theirs, ours, yours, hers and **its** are **possessive pronouns**.
EXAMPLES: That red brick house is **theirs**.
 I think this suitcase is **yours**.
