

ADJECTIVES.

- Definition :-> The words which describe the nouns or pronouns in the sentences are called Adjectives.

Adjectives are also called describing words.

EX:- Vijay is a good boy.

- Types of Adjectives :->

- ① Adjective of quality:- words that describe quality of noun or pronoun.

EX:- I have a nice teddy.
It is a cute teddy.

- ② Adjective of quantity:- words that describe quantity of noun or pronoun.

EX:- few, some, many, little, all, enough.

I have many apples with me.

Some planets have few moon.

- ③ Adjective of numbers / Numerical adjectives:- words that shows how many persons or things are there.

EX:- There are four books in the shelf.

The Earth is the fifth planet.

Types of Adjectives :-

③ Demonstrative adjectives :-

The words This, That, These and Those which describe the noun are called demonstrative adjectives.

Ex = This pen is a beautiful one.
Those boxes are very beautiful.

Demonstrative adjectives

This is a beautiful pen.

These are delicious cakes.

Demonstrative pronouns.

④ Possessive adjectives :-

The words which express the possession of the nouns are called possessive adjectives.

Ex - This is my phone.

You are writing with his pencil.

Possessive adjectives

This pen is mine.

These pencils are yours.

Possessive pronouns.
