What is Measurement?

Measurement is a process of finding a number that shows the amount of something.

To measure something is to compare to a fix standard value.

Measurement can be written using many different units.

Measurement is the action of measuring time, weight, height, temperature, length, speed and more.

Normally, we divide measurement into 3 types.

They are -

- * Measurement of length
- * Measurement of weight
- * Measurement of Capacity

Measurement of length →

To measure the size of an object, height of an object or the distance between two points is called measurement of length.

Units of Length →

We use Metres, Centimetres, millimetres and kilometres as the units of length to measure the length.

Millimetre → (mm) used to measure very small units of length.

Centimetre → (cm) used to measure small units of length.

Metre → (m) Used to measure large units of length.

Kilometre \rightarrow (km) Used to measure very large units of length.

Metre is the standard unit of length.)

In short form \rightarrow Kilometre - km

Metre \rightarrow m.

Centimetre - cm

Millimetre - mm

Remember \rightarrow 1 centimetre = 10 mm

1 metre = 100 cm.
