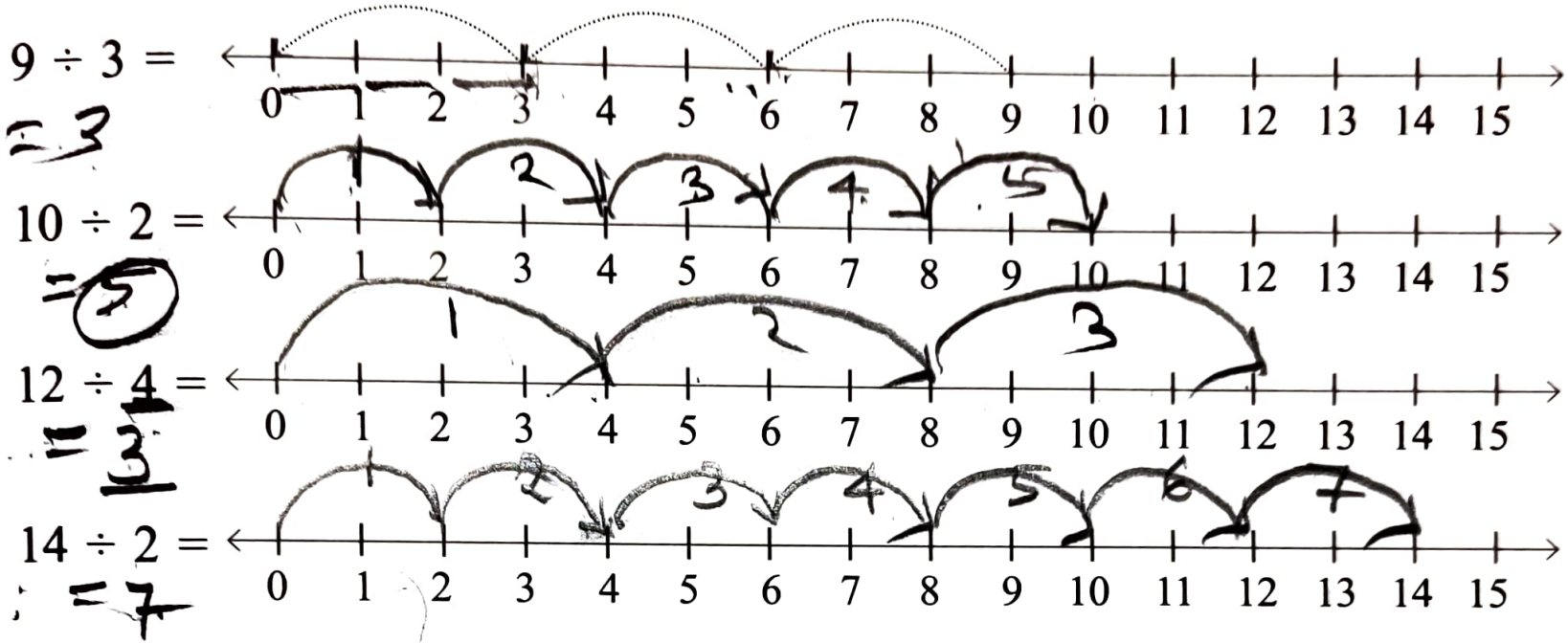


C. Show these division facts on the number lines.

1) Fill in the blanks.

a) $\boxed{\div}$ is the sign of division.

b) $\boxed{\text{Quotient}}$ is the answer of division.

e) In $12 \div 4 = 3$, $\boxed{4}$ is the divisor.

Ans $\rightarrow 18 \div 9 = 2$

b) $15 \div 5$

$$\begin{array}{r} 15 \\ - 5 \text{ --- } \textcircled{1} \\ \hline 10 \\ - 5 \text{ --- } \textcircled{2} \\ \hline 5 \\ - 5 \text{ --- } \textcircled{3} \\ \hline 0 \end{array}$$

Ans $\rightarrow 15 \div 5 = 3$
