Rainy and flood-prone regions:

* Stilt houses are constructed in rainy and flood-prone areas.

Stilts: poles on which a house is supported.

Stilt house:

* It is constructed on a raised platform [few feet above the ground]

* This house has sloping roofs to allow rainwater to drain off easily.

* Due to the structure of the house it is safe from flood water, snakes and insects.

Earthquake-prone regions:

* In these areas houses are made of wood.

* As wooden house causes less damage even if it collapses.

Note :- We have different houses in the same area as :-

→ So mud houses, brick houses, havelies in same area.

Depend on the number of people living in an area.

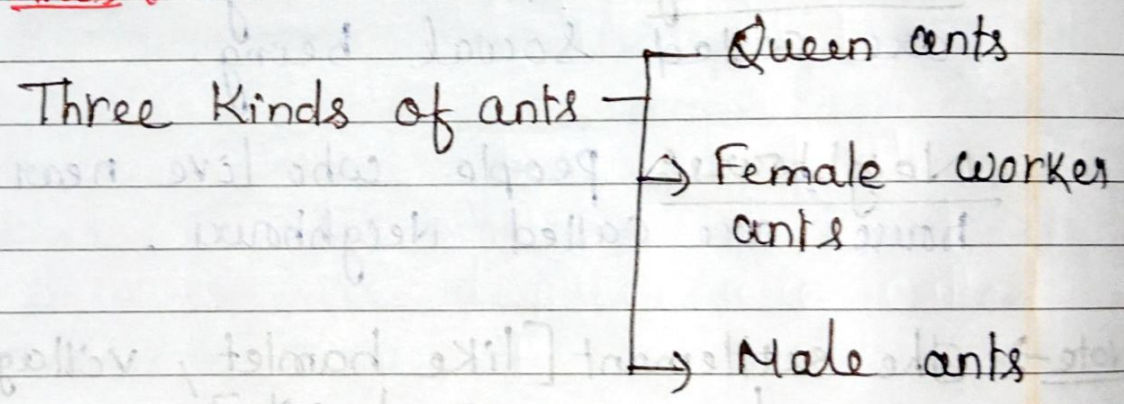
Homeless people : * People without home / who cannot afford a house
