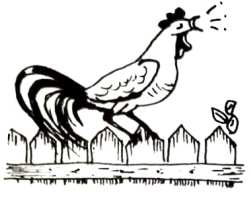


Prepositions relate one thing to another.

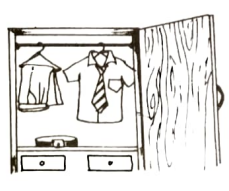

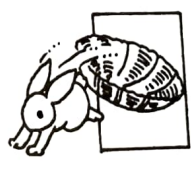
