[In Times Of Emergency]

Emergency : A situation which poses immediate threat to our life and property is called an emergency.

Natural Disaster :

An act of nature which results in loss of life and property is called a natural disaster.

Example : Earthquake, Cyclone, Tsunami, Flood.

Earthquake :

The shaking of earth due to the sudden movements below the earth's surface is called earthquake.

* Earthquake that struck in Bhuj in Gujarat [26th Jan 2001]

Cyclone:

when winds blow at a very high speed, these are called cyclones.

* cyclone in odisha [1999]

Tsunami:

Tsunamis are huge sea waves caused by an earthquake or volcanic eruption under the sea.

* Tsunami [bordering the Indian Ocean]
26th Dec 2004

Flood: Flood occurs due to heavy rain

* Mumbai flood [2005]
