- ① Eagle → make nest on the topmost branch of a tall tree.
- ② Swan → Lays eggs on a heap of plant material.
- ③ Woodpecker → Nest on trees [Tree trunk]

Animals which live on land are called terrestrial animals.

* These are made of hard mud.

* Special rooms
 → To store food
 → To take care of baby ants.

* Different rooms are connected by tunnels.

* Worker Ants: They build the rooms and tunnels. They also repair when it is damaged.

example: Frog, toad, Salamanders.

Spider's web:

- * Spider spins a web with the silk formed in its body.
- * Silk \rightarrow In form of liquid
- * Silk becomes solid \rightarrow when come in contact with air.
- * Web has blobs of glue to trap insects.
- * Thread spun by spider is very strong.
