Number of pages read by Joy = 15

Number of pages left to read

$$= 24 - 15 = \textcircled{9}$$

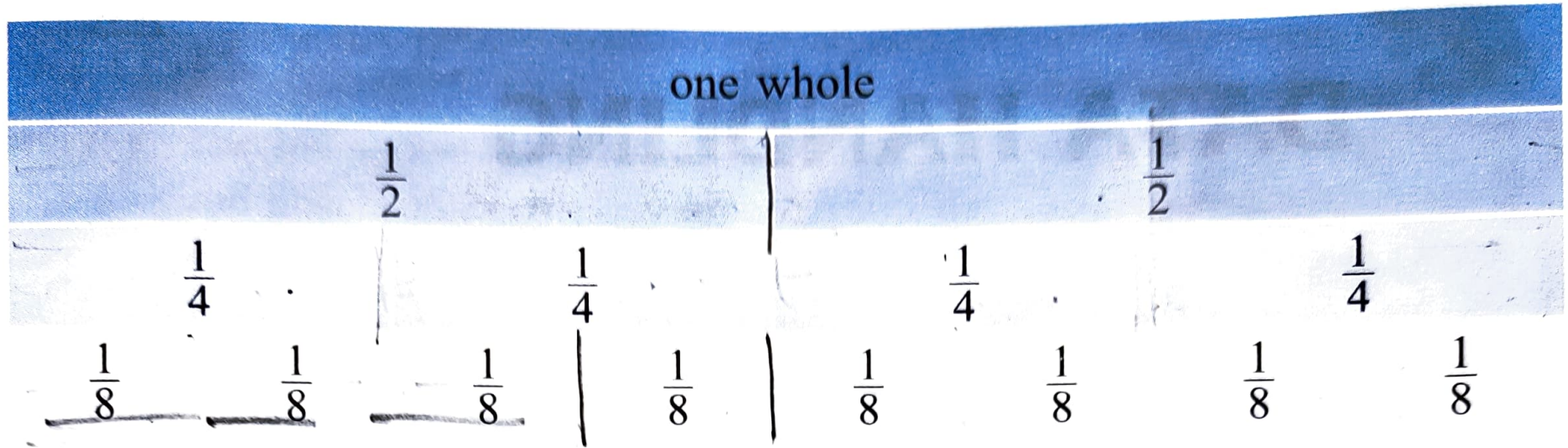
Fraction of pages are left to read
