ADJECTIVE or ADVERB

Some adjectives and adverbs have the same form.

The most important of these are

fast - fast, hard - hard

describes the noun bus
I want to take a fast bus from Pune to Mumbai. (ADJECTIVE)

modifies the verb stuck
The stone was stuck fast in the mud. (ADVERB)

describes the noun sandstone
The steps of this fort are made of hard, yellow sandstone. (ADJECTIVE)

modifies the verb work
Please work hard or you will not do well in the match. (ADVERB)

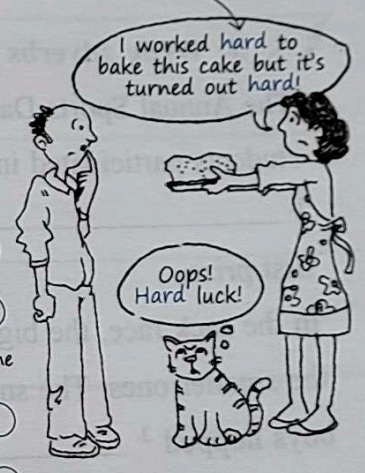
