OUR RICH HERITAGE

Monuments:

* Monuments are buildings of historical importance.

* They are built to remind people of a famous person or event.

* They tell us about the society, religious beliefs and the culture of the time ⁱⁿ which they were built.

Example: Fort, Palaces, temples, pillars and stupas.

Red Fort:

* It is also called Lal Quila

* It is built of red sandstone.

* It was built by Shah Jahan [360 Year ago]

* The beautiful structures inside it are:

- Diwan-i-Aam
- Diwan-i-Khas
- Rang Mahal
- Moti Masjid.

→ It is in Delhi

→ It is declared a World Heritage Site.

Why it is famous:

→ The Prime Minister hoists the National Flag and addresses the nation.

World Heritage Site:

* It may be a forest, mountain, lake, desert or monument

* UNESCO identifies it

* It has to be of great cultural or natural importance to humanity

UNESCO → United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation.

* It is in Agra

* It was built by Shah Jahan.

* It was built in memory of Mumtaz Mahal

↳ [wife of Shah Jahan]

* It is made of white marble.

* It is a world Heritage Site.

* It is one of among the new Seven Wonders of the world.

* Nearly 20,000 labourers took 22 years to build it.

* More than 20 types of ^{precious and} semi-precious stones were used to decorate the wall.

Built By : Pallava Kings

* The Shore temple is listed among the World Heritage Sites.

* The Pancha Ratha Temples are named after the Pandavas.

Mandapas :

* The 15 cave temples in Pancha Ratha Temples are called Mandapas.

Jaisalmer

Monuments : → Patwon Ki Haveli;

→ Golden Fort.

Patwon Ki Haveli :

* It was built by Guman chand Patwa [Merchant of Jaisalmer]

* It is built of Yellow Sandstone.

Golden Fort :

* It was built by King Jaisal

* It used to be a walled city where King (his family) and the common people lived.

* It is built of yellow sandstone.

Victoria Memorial:

- * It was built by the British in the memory of Queen Victoria.
- * It is made of white marble
- * It is used as a museum

Special feature:

- * There is an angel placed on a dome above the memorial
- * This angel used to work as a weathercock.

Other monuments:

- Sanchi Stupa
- The Ashoka pillar.
- The remains of the Nalanda University
- The Charminar
