### [Procedures in LOGO]

① What is a procedure? Explain with example?

Ans: A sequence of commands followed to solve a problem or to finish a task.

Example: To draw a square

```
To SQUARE  
  REPEAT 4 [FD 40 RT 360/4]  
END
```

③ Steps [for writing a Procedure using Input Box]

Ans: steps:

- ① Click inside the Input Box [Type the Name for the procedure]
- ② User Input Box opens  
Type the first command

③ Type the next command and press the Enter key.

④ After entering all the commands press the Enter key.

⑤ Type 'End', press the enter key.

④ How can you load a saved Procedure?

Ans: ① File Menu → Load [click]

② From the look in Drop down menu select the folder [where the file is stored]

③ click on the file name

④ click on open.

The selected file will be loaded.

Ans:

- ① File menu → click on erase
- ② You can see the titles of procedures

## NAMING A PROCEDURE

Any name can be given to a procedure. However, the following things should be kept in mind while giving a name to a procedure.

Q2 (Ans) *Q. what are the things that should be kept in mind while naming a procedure?*  
The name of the procedure should not be just a number.

- ▶ There should not be any blank space in the name of the procedure. For example, Squarebox and NOT Square box.
- ▶ The name of the procedure should not be a LOGO command. For example, End, Rt, Fd, Lt and so on cannot be given as a names of the procedure.
- ▶ The name should not have a symbol that LOGO uses such as [ or ].
