Q What is a sentence?

Ans A sentence is a group of words that makes complete sense.

\* A sentence begins with a capital letter and ends with a full stop (.), a question mark (?) or an exclamation mark (!).

\* A sentence must have a verb.

Examples

1 My father is a doctor.

2 Hockey is a wonderful game.

3 Are you going to market?

4 Thank you! You are very kind.

5 Rohan is a smart boy.

# Sentences

A sentence is a group of words that makes complete sense.

**Example** I can read this book.

A sentence begins with a capital letter and ends with a full stop (.), a question mark (?) or an exclamation mark (!).

A sentence must have a verb.

**Examples** Hockey is a wonderful game.

Are you going to school?

Thank you! You are very kind.

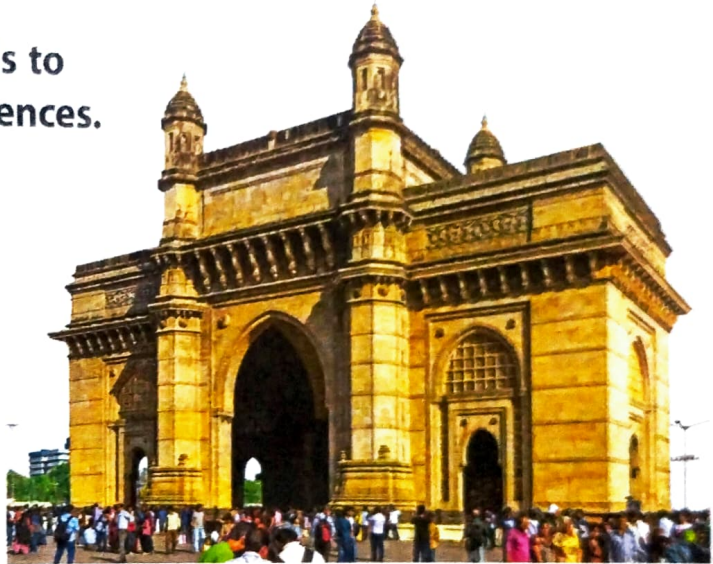
