Statement

A sentence that states a fact or an opinion is called statement. It ends with a full stop.

Examples

- 1. My father is a doctor.
- 2. Beijing is the capital of China

Interrogative Sentences

A sentence that asks something is called an interrogative sentence. It ends with a question mark,

- 1. Are you a student?
- 2. Can you swim ?


