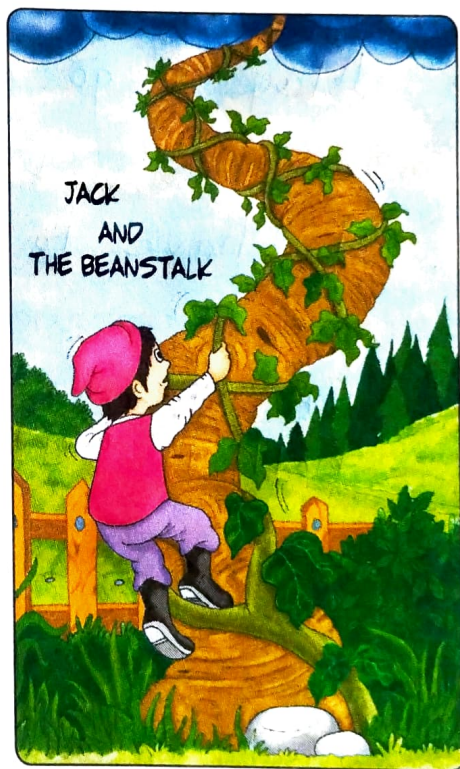

A noun that names one person, place, animal or thing is called a **singular noun**. A noun that names more than one person, place, animal or thing is called a **plural noun**. Most nouns can be changed from singular to plural by adding **s**.
