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SUBJECT AND PREDICATE

Subject means **who** or **what** the sentence is about.

Predicate means **what** action the subject does.

There is a verb in the **Predicate**.

Ex- A rainbow has seven colours .

(Subject) (Predicate)

A rainbow is the subject.

has Seven colours is the predicate.

The house has a red roof.

(Subject) (predicate)

The house is the subject.

has a red roof is the predicate.
