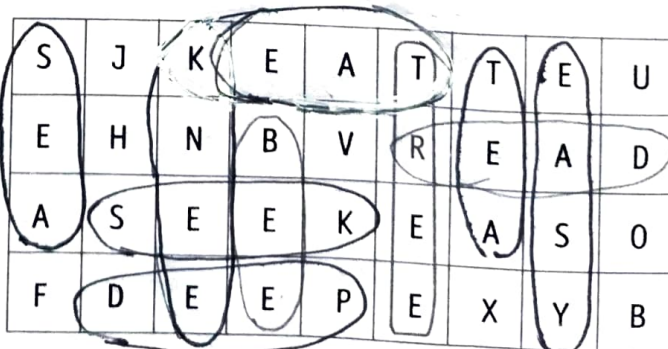

drank, got, went

I **drank** cold milk last week.

I **got** a sore throat.

I **went** to the doctor.

She **gave** me medicines.

I **got** well.

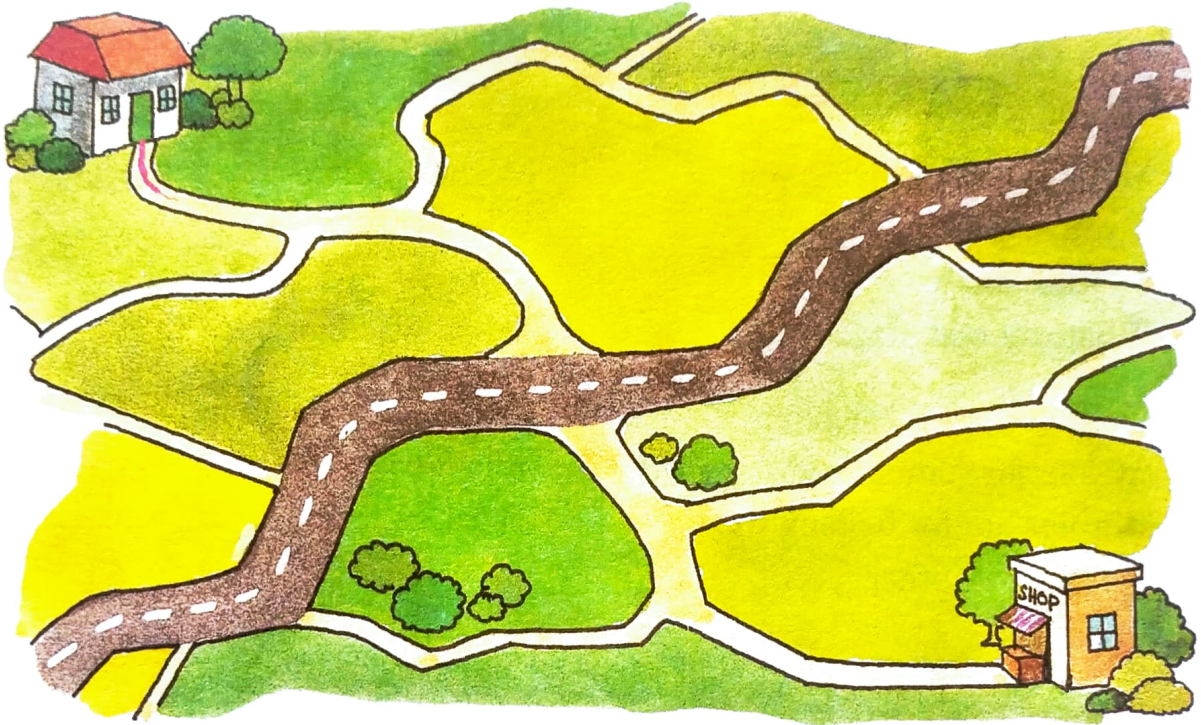
